
What is NLP?

NLP or Neuro-Linguistic Programming, was co-developed by Dr. John Grinder Ph.D. and Dr. Richard Bandler Ph.D., to model and to replicate the patterns of exceptional performance in any field.

NLP has been described as a technology based upon an attitude of curiosity towards life, coupled to a methodology of reframing. Modelling is the heart of NLP wherever NLP is practised, be it in communications, therapy, or business.

Neuro is how the brain works to take in more information and make the best use of it.

Linguistics is how we use language to structure and enrich our experience.

Programming is how we build useful habits to build success.

NLP the art and science of human excellence, is a way of bringing out the best in yourself, and in others.
