Originally modelled from the behaviours of Dr Fritz Perls, Virginia Satir and Dr Milton H Erickson, NLP is a tool of universal application. There are applications of NLP in education, music, law, communications, business, management, stagecraft, sales, public speaking, acrobatic flying, and weapons training. There are applications for NLP in every arena of human endeavour.
